

INFORMATION:

Executive Director Discussion:

- 1. Medicaid Information for June and July 2023.
- 2. Tech Initiative Update-This is regarding the Technology Grant in which the REC participates in several areas, including Academic Competition. I had the opportunity to attend the June board meeting in Hobbs where the students were recognized for winning state. I spoke with Bryan Dooley with REC9 last night and MOUs will be out next week; however, there will be a significant decrease in the amount of funds provided, as compared to last year.
- 3. NM Prek Waterford-Dymorie Maker and I attended the ECECD Prek Administration in Las Cruces and it was reported that the cost of Waterford would no longer be provided for LEAs. However, on Tuesday, August 8, 2023 we received news that the ECECD will now be covering the cost of Waterford for the 2023-2024 school year.
- 4. Resignation Deborah Dominguez-Clark-Deborah Dominguez-Clark resigned this summer. Miguel Lozano is acting as interim. He recently interacted with Pat regarding ARP funds and IDEA B carryover for our districts and how those funds can be spent and the deadline, which is September 30, 2023.
- 5. Assessment Program Memorandum-ECOT (Early Childhood Administration Tool) administration for kindergartners is no longer required; however, Istation's Mathematics Administration has been added to the ISIP early reading benchmark for all students in grades K-2. Both assessments are available in K-2 math requirement, flexibility will be granted for the beginning of the year math administration. Contact for questions, Lynn Vasquez, Division Director of Assessment and Learning Management Systems with PED.
- 6. REC7 Audit Week of August 28, 2023-The current auditor is Brent Woodard out of Clovis.
- 7. NMCEL-I attended NMCEL this summer, which was a positive experience. I was able to meet the other REC Directors and also attend SPED Legal Updates while in attendance.
- 8. New I-9 Form for Employment Eligibility Verification-Used by school districts to verify the identity and employment authorization of employees. Can be used now, but must be used by November 1, 2023.
- 9. Dwain Haynes requested a certified reviewer for DASH and recommended implementation of such, specifically for smaller schools. In addition, he explained that the staff would work through REC7. He named Denise Woody as a possibility.
