

INFORMATION:

Executive Director Discussion:

- 1. Medicaid Information for October 2023.
- 2. New Building-We have recently been notified that our building will be ready for move in soon which means we will begin to prepare for exit from the current building. It will also be necessary for the office to work remotely on November 20-21 due to internet shut down. Yesterday I did a walk through with Doug Young, architects, and construction people and we reviewed items left for completion. Security was mentioned due to safety concerns around the area of the property.

In looking at the set up of the office we would like to display pictures of old school buildings from our member districts and the new or current buildings as well as historical facts which coincide with those pictures. If you could please get with your historians or provide me with their names so that we could have copies of the pictures and work toward having those framed and included in our new office.

Gene Strickland approached the member districts regarding contributing to the cost of new furniture for the new building. The superintendents were receptive to the idea with discussion planned with their school boards. In addition, Gene indicated that there was not a constringent timeline in exiting the current building due to the fact that this building will be put up for auction, and they will be accepting bids, etc.

- 3. ED TECH BOOST Update-This program is up and running with both monthly meetings for October and one in November having taken place. Candidates are asked to attend one of two scheduled monthly meetings along with their completion of points/badges and hours. It was reported by REC9 that there may be a possibility of more funds which would allow for more participants.
- 4. Academic Competition-There are teams from Lovington, Tatum and Hobbs all competing. First virtual competition was held on 10/25/23. Tatum won the first competition. There will be two qualifying virtual competitions scheduled prior to the state competition in the spring. The top 2 varsity teams from each designated REC will compete for the title of RECA State Champion which will be held in the spring. The first state qualifying competition is being scheduled for December 6th at 1:45 through ZOOM.
- 5. Toolbox 4.3 Update-This workshop has been confirmed for January 8th in Jal. It is a full day and will be held in the cafeteria in Jal. Currently, we have approximately 56 from districts who plan to attend.

Additional Informational Items:

The REC directors met with Dr. Cage who is the new Special Education Director with PED. We all gave introductions and provided an overview of the functions of the RECs. She is unfamiliar with the operations at this time although she is currently in the process of researching many areas in her new position. She mentioned concern with compliance and accountability.

The Administrative Leadership Development Program application window in now open. The program begins in January of 2024 and goes through December. This was a requirement during the hiring process and I was not sure on the timeline for completion.

This was discussed with the superintendents and they indicated to go forward with the application process; however, there was an understanding that if it was not doable that the subsequent cohort would work.
