Family Education (12 Sessions)-One hour once a week for the first 12 weeks of treatment. Social Support (4 Sessions)-One and half hours once a week for weeks 13-16 of treatment. Individual and Conjoint Substance Abuse/Dependence Sessions (10 Sessions)-One hour weekly sessions for the first eight weeks of treatment; thereafter once a month for the two remaining months of the 16 weeks of treatment. To successfully complete the program, each participant will have documented consistent attendance with the Matrix Model-The Intensive Outpatient Program. The participant will have remained substance-free for a minimum of 90 days and shown a strong desire to abstain from drugs and alcohol. Each participant will have an establish support system in place. A participant can be terminated based on repeated non-compliance with the rules and guidelines of the program.
